Bringing the “other side of the world” a lot closer

With China’s emergence as a world economic powerhouse and strong Chinese business presence in North Carolina, students who study Chinese culture, language, and history will be in a stronger position and able to take advantage of global opportunities within N.C., the United States, and the rest of the world.

TEACHING CHINESE

Since 2010, Go Global NC (formerly the Center for International Understanding) has developed the second largest network of Confucius Classrooms in the U.S. – Utah is No. 1. Students across the state in districts large and small are studying Mandarin and learning about Chinese culture. Go Global NC is responsible for 10% of the Confucius Classrooms in the U.S., and 5% worldwide.



INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE

Go Global NC has taken more than 100 N.C. school administrators to China and hosted as many visiting Chinese principals in North Carolina for week-long global exchanges focused on culture and education.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

The North Carolina State Board of Education has an ongoing MOU with the education department of Jiangsu Province to increase global opportunities for K-12 students. Since its inception in 2008, Go Global NC has been tapped to carry out the world language and exchange opportunities envisioned by the international agreement.



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
